

Spring Select 2017 and Spring Rec2017

Registration is now open

Spring Select has **ALWAYS** been a coach driven secondary program:

The coaches observe the players throughout the fall season and begin building their Spring Select team on paper only with no contact with the parents nor players. After the fall season if they are selected as a Spring Select coach they will ask the players parents not the players, if their child would like to be on their traveling team. If the parent agrees them the coach may hand in his or her roster.

Spring REC (recreational) Program:

Is primarily in house only or with a neighboring region if need be. There will be as many teams as there are parents willing to coach. In the Spring Recreational play we need a minimum of four teams per division. Six would be ideal.

What is the Registration fee?

The registration fees are as follows:

Spring Select 2017 is \$110 per returning fall player (U10-U16).

Spring Rec 2017 is \$110 per returning fall player (U7-U14) or \$130 for new players that did not play fall 2016.

Spring Rec 2017 for U5 & U6 returning players \$80, or \$100 for new players that did not play fall 2016. U5 will be combined with U6.

No online payments will be accepted for spring. Payments can be made via credit card, cash or check in the month of January 2017 in person at Sierra field (**registration dates will be announced soon**). After January 31, only credit cards, money orders or cash will be accepted. No personal checks.

When making your payment at the field be sure to include a copy (printed out) no smartphones of the registration paper work. You must print the **first page** of the registration form (Player form). Please follow the instructions on the eayso.org site to properly print out the form.

Who can register for Spring Select and who can register for Spring Recreational play?

Registration for Spring Select is open to current registered players from the fall 2016 season only. For Spring Select you must first be contacted by the head coach of your division asking to be on his or her team. See below for Returning players

Registration for Spring Recreational play; is open to current registered players from the fall 2016 and new applicants. **Spring Recreational play;** you must first be contacted by the head

coach of your division asking to be on his or her team. See below for New Players

Where can registration be completed?

Registration can be completed online only at www.eayso.org. See the section below for returning players or new players

Returning players, players that played in the current fall 2016 season, do the following

Login to www.eayso.org (where you registered for the fall 2016 season)

On the bottom left click **Sign up for Other Programs**

read the pop-up box message and click ok

Select the player and click Signup link under the Sign up for Spring column.

New players, create a login account and complete the application process.

What volunteers are needed?

Each team will need two coaches, three referees, & field setup. When you register be prepared to volunteer.

How many teams will there be?

There will be as many teams as there are parents willing to coach. In the Spring Recreational play we need a minimum of four teams per division. Six would be ideal.

How can I volunteer?

AYSO is a parent volunteer program which is the key to offering an affordable program.

When will teams be made?

As soon as we have the coaches in place

All coaches will come to the team meeting scheduled for early February 2017.

What are the dates for Spring practices and games?

Team practices would be twice a week starting as early as 5pm and no later than 7:30pm. The team coach would have specific times. Practice would start the week February 13.

The current plan would be to have a game every Saturday starting March 11 and ending Saturday, May 20. There may be some midweek games if necessary.

What about refunds?

A full refund will be provided when a written request is mailed to Region 75 PO box by February 12, 2017 or if you are not placed on a team. No refunds will be issued after the February 12, 2017.

Is there traveling involved in the spring season?

For Spring Select teams in the age group of U10 and greater, yes, you can expect to travel up to 20 miles away for a game.

For teams in Spring Rec play and teams under the age of 8, most games are here in Whittier, however it depends greatly on the number of players that sign up and the coaches that volunteer. U6 plays only at Sierra Field.
