

POINT SYSTEM

All teams will start out with 300 points

If the team fails to provide volunteers' every week, they will lose points:

- Center or sideline referee is -10 points
 - Friday cleanup is -5 points
 - Early Saturday Morning setup is -5 points
 - Last game teardown is -5 points
 - Snack shack duty is -5 points
1. Every team has to provide three certified referees every weekend no exceptions. Failure to provide 3 referees will be a 10 point deduction for each referee no-show.
 2. Every Friday there will be field and AYSO parking lot cleanup, failure to provide one person will be a 5 point deduction.
 3. Early Saturday Morning setup: Team's must set up their own goal 30min. before their game starts, if the game starts late, time will be taken out of that game.
 4. Last game teardown: Teams will take down the net, goal, poles and the spikes and take them to the container and put them in their designated spot's. Failure to tear down will be a 5 point deduction.
 5. Snack shack duty: Every Saturday people that are assigned must help one hour in the snack shack. Schedules for each team and times will be posted in bulletin board on the shed. Failure to show up will be a 5 point deduction.

How the system will be used:

U8 division: The U8 division IS NOT competitive. Scores will not be kept. Lineup cards will be utilized to ensure each child is receiving their allotted playing time. There will be a U8 tournament at the end of the season. Top 4 teams from each division (4 from Boys, 4 from Girls) will be selected based on most volunteer points maintained throughout the season. Point tie breakers will be resolved via a coin flip by the Regional Commissioner.

U10-U14: We will be using the 10 Point system (6 points for a win, 1 point per goal, maximum 3 goals and 1 point for a shutout). In the event of a Draw, each team will be awarded 3 points, plus their number of goals scored, maximum of 3. These divisions ARE competitive. Final season standings will be determined by TOTAL POINTS! Total points

will be a combination of: Win/Loss/Draws AND Volunteer Points maintained. Total Point ties will be determined by a playoff.

Teams cannot earn more than the 300 volunteer points they started with.

There is the possibility that a team with a worse Win/Loss/Draw record will have more Total Points than a team with a better Win/Loss/Draw record, because they maintained more of their Volunteer Points.

Final season standings will be determined by TOTAL POINTS.
